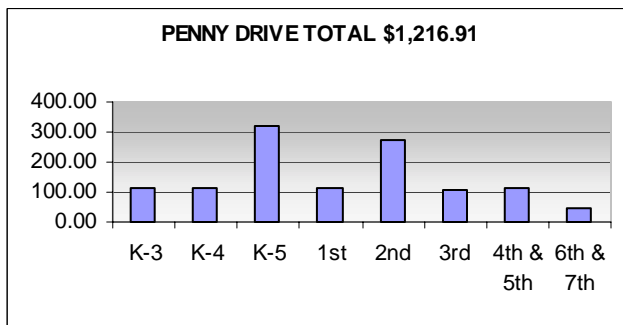

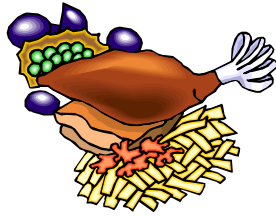

MUSIC NEWS

The piano class students went to the Keyboard Festival on Saturday, January 24, 2004. This event was held at First Baptist Church, West Monroe, and was sponsored by the Southern Baptist Convention. The purpose of this event was to mold the students' abilities so they may see how to use their gift as a future church leader. Students went prepared to play a hymn of their choice. They were judged by local church pianists and piano teachers on note accuracy, rhythm accuracy, interpretation, tone quality, technique in which they played their hymn, and their poise and posture while playing. There were a possible of 60 points they could earn in these categories. If the student earned 52 points or higher, they received a "superior", and was awarded a certificate stating so. Also, on their score sheets the judges wrote comments to encourage the student in their strong points and suggest some things in their weak points. All 14 students who participated in the festival made a "superior" in Level 1 and are listed below.
