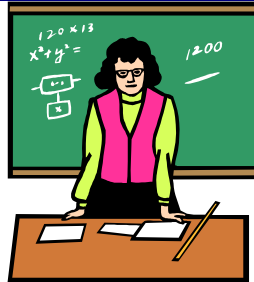

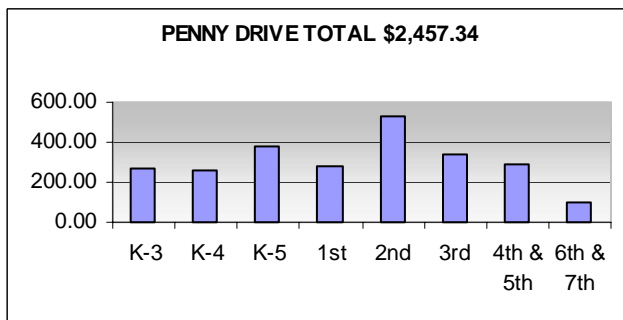


Christian Education Shaping the Future Generations.

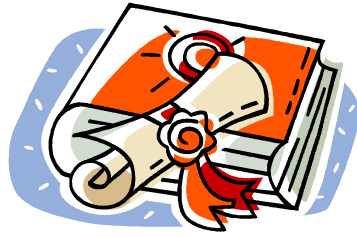
