First Assembly of God Church

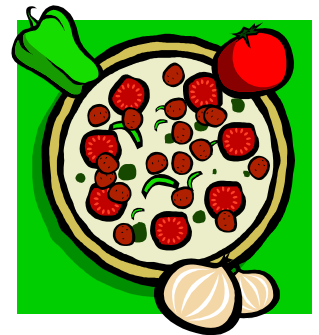

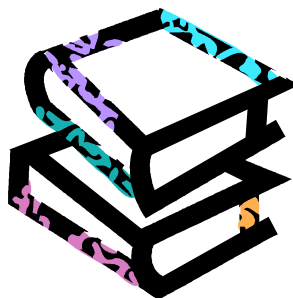

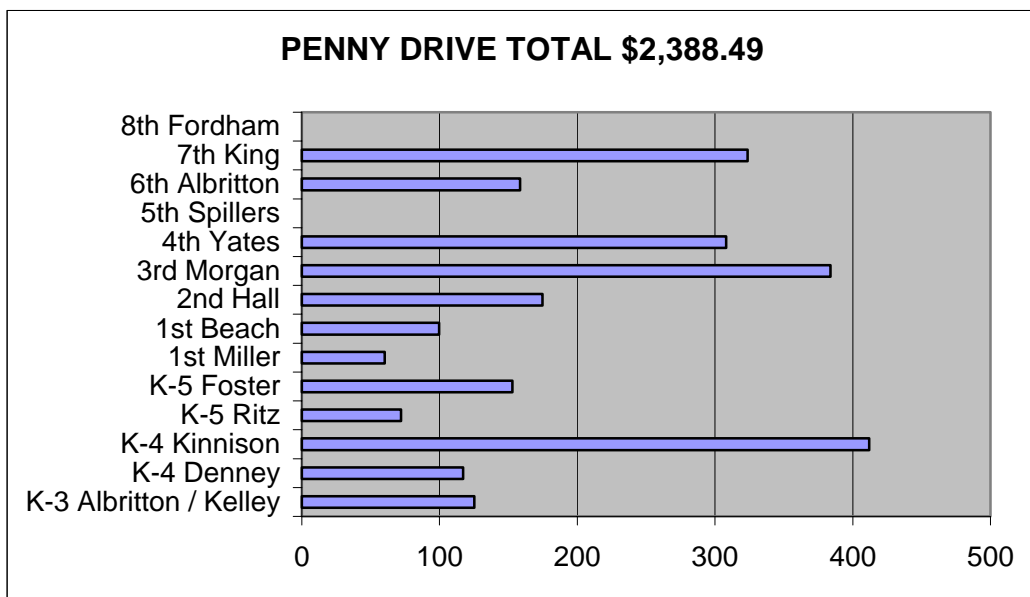
