ATHLETIC NEWS!!

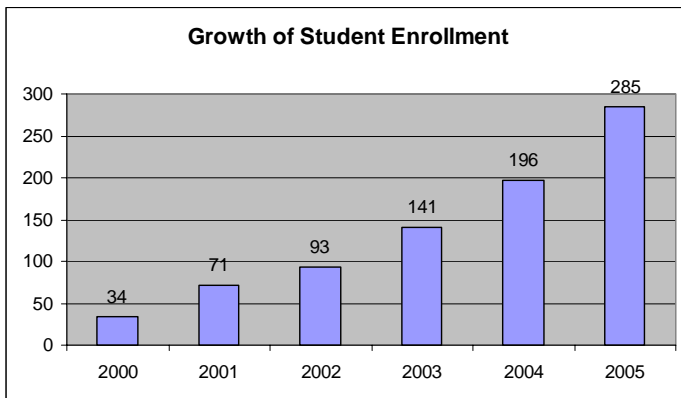
