Easter is always the 1st Sunday after the 1st full moon following the Spring Equinox (March 20).

**Friday, April 11, will be a teacher in-service day. There will be no school!**

This dating of Easter is based on the Lunar calendar that Hebrew people used to identify Passover, which is why it moves around on our Roman calendar.

Based on the above information, Easter can actually be one day earlier, March 22, but that is rare.

This year is the earliest Easter any of us will ever see the rest of our lives! Only the most elderly of our population have ever seen it this early (age 95 or older), and none of us have ever, or will ever, see it a day earlier!

The next time Easter will be on March 23 will be in 2228 (220 years from now).

The last time it was this early was 1913.

The next time it will be March 22 will be in 2285 (277 years from now).

The last time it was on March 22 was 1818.
