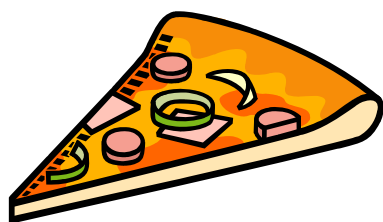
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# C O U N S E L O R ' S C O R N E R

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**UCA TEEN TALENT CONTEST**  
**7:00 pm – Saturday – December 1, 2007**  
**Rules and Regulations**

1. **Teen Talent** is an annual event that showcases the Christian talents of young performers in music, drama, dance, art, and ministerial gifting. This event is open to teens or students attending UCA. It is a talent contest and talent show, and it provides an opportunity for young people to share God's gifting with others.
2. The Teen Talent Show is open to any 7<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade student attending UCA.  
**Exception: Church Youth Groups competing most have a minimum of 2 UCA students performing with the group. All other participants must be 7<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade students.**
3. Categories are:
  - **Vocal** (solo, duet, ensemble)
  - **Instrumental** (solo, duet, ensemble)
  - **Theater/Drama** (human videos, dramas, puppetry, comedy routine, skits, etc)
  - **Short Sermons** (children's sermon, adult sermon, etc)
  - **Dance** (tap, ballet, etc)
  - **Church Youth Group Category**; (skits, dramas, ensemble, etc) No group larger than 10 performers, and a minimum of 2 UCA students per group.
  - **Art Division** (photography, painting, sculpting, etc)
  - Any questions concerning talent show performing arts not listed above please contact show organizers.
4. The Godly standard that we believe can be fairly applied regarding appropriateness is the following: The lyrics, actions, and dress code of any entry must comply with all school policies for student conduct. In other words, performers may not sing about, discuss, or pantomime any activity that students could not actually say or do on school grounds.
5. It is strongly recommended that a performance run no more than 5 minutes. Every performance should have a Christian message. **No one performance may have more than 10 participants performing.**
6. **Vocals** may have an instrumental accompaniment by the person in the act or others is allowed, but is not judged. It must assume the pure character of accompaniment. The test shall be whether the performance would stand alone.
7. A cassette tape must be cued properly. We cannot be responsible for any tape or CD, which is not picked up following your performance. Please label each tape with your name for identification.
8. In the **Instrumental** performances, live or taped accompaniment is allowed but must assume the pure character of accompaniment. The test shall be whether the performance would stand alone. The use of any instrument(s) being judged is not allowed. In the use of any electronic keyboard, no preprogrammed music is allowed; the contestant must create all sound live on stage.
9. In the **Dance** performances, accompanists are permitted, but must not assume visual importance in the performance.
10. In the **Theater/Drama** performances; Performers are allowed to dress into character, but no props will be allowed. Each group will have the option to use 4 folding metal chairs (supplied) if wanted. Each performance should have a Christian message,
11. In the **Vocal** and/or **Instrumental** performance, any combination or vocal and/or instrumental performance will be accepted, including bands with or without vocals. In this case the entry will only be adjudicated in the contestant's chosen category.
12. The **Art Division**; Each entry will be on display and judged before the Talent Show. The audience will also have the opportunity to vote for their favorite piece. Each entry should have a Christian message.
13. **Church Youth Group Category**; (skits, dramas, ensemble, etc) No group larger than 10 performers, and a minimum of 2 UCA students per group. Performances must have a Christian message and theme.

Organizers reserve the right of final decision on any matters pertaining to the Teen Talent not covered by the rules.

#### **Adjudication**

During the show, judge's score will be counted as 75% of the total points given while the remaining 25% will be awarded by the audience present that night. Judges score cards will be in three categories: Presentation 25%, Creativity 25%, Ministerial effectiveness 25%; equaling 75% of total points. Audience ballots will count for 25 %.
