UCA POSTS NINTH CONSECUTIVE ENROLLMENT RECORD

Union Christian Academy school President Paul Murray announced today that enrollment at the Farmerville-based school achieved a new record, with 432 students for the 2008-09 year.

"The number represents an increase of 13.7% over last year's enrollment. We want to give glory to God for the great things He is doing at UCA." Murray continued, "There is more excitement this year about things going on at Union Christian than I can remember. Folks are really pumped up about what's happening!"

Excitement around "what's happening" might include the recent announcement by the young school of its intent to secure academic and athletic alignment and accreditation with the Mississippi Private School Association in 2009, or possibly the proposed 21-acre brand new Lions Athletic Complex. It might also be the excitement building around UCA having its first graduating Senior Class this year. With 2007-08 standardized

test scores in the top 30% in the nation, UCA seems to be headed in the right direction. Murray adds, "We believe God has established something very special in our Parish. Something positive and exciting around which we can all rally. This is a special time and UCA is a special place to be."
